

ENEL COLOMBIA S.A ESP NOTICES PUBLISHED BY THE COMPANY SEPTEMBER 16, 2022

ENEL COLOMBIA informs that after 30 days of demonstrations, the community of Ubalá lifted the blockades that restricted access and free mobility to the El Guavio hydroelectric power plant.

To resume normal operation of the plant and start preventive maintenance of the four major units that are unavailable today, totaling 1,000 MW, the Company has a team of more than 35 people who will work in shifts 24 hours a day to seek the gradual restoration of the generation units. 1,000 MW, the Company has a team of more than 35 people, who will work in shifts 24 hours a day, to seek the gradual reestablishment of the generation units.

The lifting of the blockade came about after a consultation meeting convened by the Ministry of the Interior with the participation of the community of the Guavio region, the Ministry of Mines and Energy, the governments of Cundinamarca and Boyacá, municipal mayors, Enel Colombia and some companies present in the territory.

Enel Colombia will also voluntarily participate in a framework agreement with the Government of Cundinamarca and Grupo de Energía de Bogotá, through which it will contribute \$2 billion pesos and yellow machinery for the improvement of roads in the territory, representing an additional \$2 billion pesos.
